As one Welcoming Eucharistic Community we are called to share our faith in Jesus Christ through catechesis, evangelization, and service.

Dear Parishioners,

Beginning Saturday, January 25, through Tuesday, February 4, 2025, you may submit your recommendation for a new name for our parish. All are welcome and strongly encouraged to be involved in this process. Invoking the guidance of the Holy Spirit, may we each recommend a parish name that reflects the mission and vision of our new parish.

Please review the parameters for choosing a new parish name before submitting your recommendation:

Per Canon Law, after parishes are merged a new parish name must be chosen. The parameters for choosing a new parish name are:

- 1. the name of the Trinity, or
- 2. a name for Christ, invoked in the liturgy, or a mystery of his life, or
- 3. the name of the Holy Spirit, or
- 4. a name for Mary, invoked under a title for her used in the liturgy, or
- 5. the name of a holy angel, or
- 6. the name of a canonized saint, as it appears in the Roman martyrology (or appendix), or
- 7. the name of a blessed provided the Apostolic See has given its permission.

Annotated Code of Canon Law ¶1218 (commentary): "There must be only one title, with the exceptions of the Holy Trinity or of saints whose names are joined together in the calendar."

De Patronis constituendis (Sacra Congregatio Pro Culto Divino, 19 March 1973, n. 3): "There should be only one principal patron. However, when two or more saints are inscribed in the Roman Calendar together, they may together be chosen as the principal patrons (e.g., Saints Basil and Gregory or Saints Martha, Mary, and Lazarus of Bethany) (cf. ibid., n. 5)."

Because Saint Ambrose and Saint Anne are not connected in the Tradition, they cannot be combined to create the name of the new parish.

The Diocese of Joliet requires that the new parish name must be unique among the names of parishes and churches that are in the diocese. Please see the other side of this sheet for a list of all parishes in the Diocese of Joliet. The names on this list CANNOT be considered for our new parish name.

After the survey results are evaluated and parish meetings are held, Father Anthony will present a short list of parish name recommendations to Bishop Hicks, who has the authority to make the final decision.

You may complete the survey online, in-person after weekend Masses in the classroom hallway, in-person at the parish office during normal office hours, or by calling the parish office during normal office hours.

When completing the survey, you will be asked to provide the following:

Are you a parishioner of St. Ambrose and St. Anne Parish? (optional)

What name do you recommend for the parish? (required)

Please provide a brief reason for the name you recommend. (required)

May the Holy Spirit guide us in this process.
